OBJECTS: The objects for which the Bundaberg Christian College is established are:

- (a) to provide such educational or other programmes or institutions as will assist members to live whole and balanced life-styles and to be a blessing to the society in which they live.
- (b) To contribute to the educational facilities available in the State of Queensland by establishing and maintaining in such suitable places that may be thought convenient pre-school, primary, secondary, technical and further education and other educational facilities or institutions and child care centres of the highest standards for the purpose of achieving the goals hereinafter mentioned namely:
 - (i) to provide an education of high academic standards that is based on:
 - an acceptance of the Lordship of Christ and
 - an acceptance of the Bible as the revealed word of God as these are defined in the Doctrinal Basis of the School.
 - (ii) to provide an education of high academic and technical standards that also:
 - fosters self discipline in the learner while teaching him to accept the discipline of the Church which is the Body of Christ, to be obedient to his parents and to obey the laws of the Government.
 - Caters for the individuality of the learner and stresses the function of the learner as a member of the Body of Christ and of the community.
 - Trains the learner in the moral and ethical standards of the Bible as interpreted in the teaching of the New Testament and assists him to acquire a biblical world and life view and to appreciate the rights of others to hold different views.
 - Develop the learner's creative and critical abilities and
 - Stresses co-operation rather than competition and fosters the development of the gifts, skills and abilities of the learner for the service of Jesus Christ in the Body of Christ and the community.

Bundaberg Christian College



The Doctrinal basis of the College is as follows:

The School accepts, adapts and adheres to the following Doctrinal basis:

We believe that the Bible is God's written Word, divinely inspired and infallible in the original autographs of the thirty-nine books of the Old Testament and the twenty-seven books of the New Testament in their entirety, and we therefore believe that the Holy Spirit supernaturally guided the human authors to write authoritative statements of truth that are the supreme basis for Christian belief and conduct.

We believe that there is one God in whom there are three co-equal and co-eternal Persons, revealed as the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit, and we believe that God, of his own sovereign will, created the Universe and all that is contained within.

We believe that the Lord Jesus Christ is the uncreated, externally existing, only begotten Son of the father, and that He became a man, conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the virgin Mary, lived a sinless human life, offered Himself as the perfect atoning sacrifice upon the Cross, was raised from the dead, and ascended to heaven where He is now seated at the Father's right hand.

We believe that the Holy Spirit, co-equal with the Father and the Son, is present in the world to convict people of their sin and their need for the Saviour, to lead them to repentance and to regenerate and indwell those who believe in Jesus Christ as Lord. We also believe that the indwelling Holy Spirit seeks to enable each believer to live in a manner worthy of his or her calling in Christ by manifesting the fruit of the Spirit in his or her life, and bestows at least one spiritual gift upon each believer to prepare him or her for Christian service.

We believe that human beings, both male and female, are in the spiritual image of God and the supreme creatures within His Creation. We also believe that, through the rebellion and disobedience of the first human beings, this image was marred and that all people are now in a fallen and lost condition which has separated them from God and caused disharmony between themselves.

We believe that human beings can never make up for their sin by self-improvement or good works and that salvation from the penalty and consequences of sin is offered as a free gift of God and is found only through a personal acceptance of substitutionary atoning death and bodily resurrection of the Lord Jesus Christ.

We believe that human beings were created to live forever, either existing externally separated from God in Hell because of sin, or living eternally with God because of personal faith in the Lord Jesus Christ.

We believe in the actual existence of the Devil, originally created by God in a perfect state, but he chose to rebel against God's authority and is now the father of all evil and opposed to God and God's purposes and seeks to tempt God's people away from the ways of God. We also believe that Satan was defeated through the bodily resurrection of the Lord Jesus Christ, and he is ultimately subject to the purposes of God and will be confined forever to Hell.

We believe that the Church is composed of all believers in the Lord Jesus Christ, and finds manifestation in each of the local churches.

We believe in the future, personal return to earth of the Lord Jesus Christ, at which time will commence the glorious reign of Christ, and then, the full realisation of the Eternal Kingdom of God.
